


MCKINNEY AT A GLANCE

One of the fastest-growing cities in the United States and ranked #2 in Smart Asset's Safest Cities in America - 2023 Edition, McKinney Texas is located just 30 miles north of Downtown Dallas. Originally established in 1848 and growing ever since, the last 175 years have provided McKinney the opportunity to become a sought-after spot to live, work, and play.

COST OF LIVING

On average, McKinney is 4% less expensive compared to National averages, but is the 39th most expensive city in Texas. Costs for food and transportation tend to be more expensive when compared to other communities, and housing costs are similar to National averages.

CLIMATE

The average annual temperature in McKinney is 65.7 degrees Fahrenheit, with about 43.7" of annual precipitation. The hottest month of the year is typically August, and coldest is January.












AVG. TRANSACTION TIMELINE


